Concerned about your information being shared?

Patient data from GP Medical records kept by GP practices in England is used respectfully, securely and safely every day to improve health, care and services through planning and research, helping to find better treatments and improve patient care. Data collected by the NHS is only used for health and care purposes. It is never shared with marketing or insurance companies. The NHS is planning to introduce an improved way for GP practices to share information about patients called the general practice data for planning and research data collection. News of these plans has caused some concern to some of our patients who have decided they don't want their data to be involved. If you have already contacted the surgery to ask to opt out of your identifiable information being shared your request will be honoured. This will not affect your own care. However nobody's data will be shared in this way until 1st September
